We are also looking for corporate sponsorship and have already received a \$2,000 sponsorship gift from Mike Robinson's company, Robinson HVAC, which paid for prime rib at Philbrook. We are making some calls to those we feel could give other larger gifts. The bottom line is as of today,

We need to raise an additional \$35,000!!!

Today, I am announcing the launch of the public phase of our fundraising campaign.
